Teen Trip to La Ceiba, Honduras



Our teens, parents, and adult leaders will be traveling to La Ceiba, Honduras this Summer, from August 7th through August 16th. While there, the group plans to finish up construction of a soccer field at a local Nazarene church. We will be doing VBS-style missions there and at other surrounding churches. Also, the group plans to connect with a local ministry in the area called "Helping Honduras Kids", an organization that runs a "jungle school" outside of the city for 200+ kids.

Work & Witness Trip to Granja, Honduras



The Hagerstown and Bel Air congregations will join together in September to complete work on the Granja Church as well as provide ministry to children, including orphans. While the Granja Church will be nearly complete, we will do the electrical work and construct a security fence. We anticipate ministering to over 1200 children. This will be the third church building we have constructed in the past few years through our partnership with the Mother Church in Honduras.

Carlos and Robin Rađi are global missionaries for the Church of the Nazarene, serving in Argentina.

The Rađis have been Nazarene missionaries since 1999. Carlos grew up as a Nazarene pastor's son in Argentina. He shares, "My call is to minister, preach and serve so that I can efficiently raise up leaders for the next generation." Robin's parents are Nazarene missionaries who served in Peru, Costa Rica, and Lebanon. Carlos and Robin were sent out as hurricane relief W & W coordinators in the Dominican Republic. Upon completing the reconstruction, they served in Guatemala as missions coordinators for the Mexico and Central American Region.

The Rađis now minister at the Southern Cone Field Office in Argentina. Carlos and Robin are the Multi Ministry Coordinators and the W & W Coordinators for Argentina. They also pastor a local church. Carlos is currently serving as DS for the Native People's District and the Buenos Aires West District. Robin says, "We feel that in developing better ministries at a local, district and national level in South America, we are truly answering our call to "Go and make disciples."
